



1. BEFORE TRAVELLING TO PEELBERGEN

- 1.1. Monitor and record the temperature of each of your horses twice a day for the 10 days leading up to the event (starting immediately if the event starts in less than 10 days) on the attached Temperature Record Sheet (annex 1).
- 1.2. Fill in the attached FEI Equine Health Self-Certification form (annex 2) and keep this form in the horse's passport.
- 1.3. Pack a thermometer and maybe a back-up thermometer too.

2. UPON ARRIVAL AT PEELBERGEN

- 2.1. Park your truck at the directions of our parking attendants.
- 2.2. We are not longer requiring a negative covid test. So you can skip this part and go directly to the stable managers office to check in and get your stable numbers.
- 2.3. Now it is time to unload your horses and place your horses in the allocated stables (with or without first bedding). At every horse stable we have provided a Temperature record sheet. Please fill in the required contact details and note the twice daily temperature checks on this sheet.
- 2.4. Fill in the Horse registration form and place the form in the designated box. This will prompt a veterinarian to come and check your horses. Wait at the stables and have your horses' passports, Equine Health Self-Certification form and thermometer ready.
- 2.5. Please paste the Temperature record sheet we have provided at the stable door. Please fill in the required contact details and note the twice daily temperature checks on this sheet. (between 07h00 - 10h00 and between 18h00 -21h00)

GENERAL RULES AT PEELBERGEN

- We are open for public, no covid test required. Please keep the 1,5m distance and do not come to our show when you have any covid symptoms.
- Everyone has to take a place and be seated when watching the competition.
- Max 4 persons at one table, please do not move chairs/tables.
- Trucks & horses may only arrive Tuesday between 15h00 – 21h00
- To minimize the risk of any virus spreading, **all dogs must be leashed** and be accompanied by a human or tied to stationary object. Violation of this rule means you will receive a €100 euro fine. No warnings will be given.
